PORTFOLIO/PAST AND CURRENT ACTIVITIES:

The Katadrom Arts, Culture, and Social Politics Association was founded in 2010 by a group of filmmakers, festival organisers, writers, journalists, and expatriates. Their motivation was to create a common ground for their collective and individual creative endeavours at a *cross-cultural level using audio-visual media and cinema*. Katadrom Art is an organisation that *specialises in cultural and artistic events, capacity building, educational activities/programs, and audio-visual production.*

The primary aim of the Katadrom Association is to stimulate cultural appreciation and integration by supporting artistic and cultural creativity in all its forms and to encourage dialogue among communities.

Within the Katadrom Association, the concepts of culture, art, and social policy are considered holistically rather than separately. In its projects, which encompass various categories such as festivals, youth camps, art workshops, film days, and educational programs, *Katadrom places a strong emphasis on women's rights, gender equality, anti-discrimination, the protection of vulnerable groups, and the culture of coexistence, viewing these not only as priorities but as central issues*.

Katadrom Association is an institution that has taken on the general coordination, curation, and consultancy of film programs and events, primarily in the fields of cinema and media. It organizes national and international projects and cultural, art, and social policy education events in collaboration with numerous organisations.

Furthermore, over the past ten years, we have been involved in *capacity building, media, new technologies, event management, empowerment training, and development for Human Rights Defenders, Adult Educators, NGO Workers, Refugee Children, LGBTI+ Parents, and Youth*.

Our specific expertise in training and skills in communication and new media enable us to build strong connections between different social groups. We work with a wide variety of social groups, ranging from political and racial groups to age and gender groups.

Katadrom is the only institution in Turkey's history to hold a public movie premiere at *Halki/ Heybeliada Seminary*.

Katadrom is a dynamic non-governmental organisation dedicated to fostering cultural exchange, promoting the arts, and nurturing cross-disciplinary collaborations. It is an organisation which specialises in cultural and artistic events, capacity building, educational activities/programs and audio-visual production.

We believe in the transformative power of culture and the arts to inspire dialogue, encourage diversity, and spark positive change in society.

In the Katadrom Association, we view culture, art, and social policy as intertwined, reflected in our diverse projects promoting women's rights, gender equality, anti-discrimination, and coexistence.

Objectives:

Cultural Exchange: We believe that culture and the arts can bridge gaps and promote mutual understanding between people from different backgrounds, leading to meaningful cross-cultural interactions.

Artistic Promotion: We provide platforms for artists to exhibit their work, perform, and collaborate with others to reach wider audiences and fulfill their artistic potential.



Cross-Disciplinary Collaborations: Our main experience is to encourage cross-disciplinary collaborations among artists, researchers, and professionals to address complex societal challenges and promote innovation.

Community Engagement, Responsibility and Diversity: Our objectives include creating cultural events and initiatives that resonate with local audiences, offering educational programs that empower communities, and fostering inclusivity by promoting underrepresented voices in the arts and culture while advocating for gender equality in all our projects and events.

Cultural Heritage Preservation: We value cultural heritage preservation, initiating projects to document, archive, and celebrate cultural expressions for ongoing enrichment.

International Collaboration: Katadrom has successfully collaborated with many cultural institutions in Asia, Africa and the Americas, particularly in Europe, and is seeking to expand its worldwide network of partners and collaborators.

Youth Empowerment: We organise youth-focused programs, mentorship opportunities, and educational initiatives that nurture creativity and critical thinking.

Advocacy: We advocate for the role of culture and the arts in society, participate in policy discussions, and strengthen the audiovisual capacity of rights-based NGOs.We are proud to have been working on capacity building, media, new technologies, event managing, empowerment training and development in 10 years for Human Right Defenders, Adult Educators, NGO' Workers, Refugee Children, LGBTI+ Parents, Youth.

Sustainability: Sustainability is at our core. We promote eco-responsible practices and embed sustainability in all we do.

Through these objectives, we aim to contribute to a more culturally enriched and diverse world, where collaboration and creativity pave the way for a brighter future.

Each event produces its own printed or digital catalogues, printed or digital books, films, trailers, and digital documents and photographs, which are made available on our websites.

The Katadrom Association has so far failed numerous international events and projects, both with its own resources and with the contributions of its private or public supporters.

Although there is no public or private institution behind the Katadrom that supports it, even with limited and temporary financial support, it has signed projects of almost the same scale and number as some well-established culture and art institutions in Turkey, which are backed by large private companies and holdings.




Since 2019 Katadrom Art Colony:

Since 2020 - during the year, 3- 4 program:

Sinematek/Sinema Evi - Kadikoy Municipality Cinematheque/Cinema House

Katadrom conducts its official collaboration with its partner, the sister media and production agency Atonic Project. Katadrom's responsibilities encompass subtitle translation, subtitled DCP production, technical operations on copies, and other tasks related to the program's copy supply correspondence.

The entire budget for Katadrom is covered by the **Kadıköy Municipality**. The Sinematek/ Cinematheque organises four distinct programs throughout the year as follows:

January to March: Held in the main building complex. April to June: Conducted in the main building complex. Between July and September: Features outdoor screenings in the park. October to December: Hosted in the main building complex.

For instance, as part of the 2023 budget, Katadrom received a total allocation of 35,000 euros at the current exchange rate for these four periods.

(When calculated using the January 2023 exchange rate, this budget equates to 50,000 euros.)






Pantaflix - Germany (2016-19)

First Public Event at Halki/ Heybeliada Seminary

Katadrom is the only institution in Turkey's history to hold a public movie premiere at Heybeliada Seminary. The premiere of Robert Sava's movie The Savior was held, and this event resonated all over the world and in Turkey, both in politics and in the arts and culture world.

The school served as the principal theological institution of the Eastern Orthodox Church under the Ecumenical Patriarchate of Constantinople until 1971. At that time, a Turkish parliamentary law was enacted, resulting in the closure of private higher education institutions, including this theological school. As of now, the institution remains closed for public events.



Some of the tasks we undertake:

The experiences and connections of the founders and members of the Katadrom Association in the fields of culture, art, education, and academia make the association competent in the realization of national and international projects and activities.

For nearly twenty years, there have been events such as the Cinema History Meeting, Amsterdam Turkish Films Week, Greece Film Days, Rome Turkish Film Days Week, International Bursa Silk Road Film Festival, Bodrum Environment Film Days, Black Sea Countries Film Week, and Flying Broom Film Festival, Criminal Law Congress. In addition to being the General Coordinator and Program Coordinator, Consultant in many international film festivals and congress organizations, the entire International Crime and Punishment Film Festival and Edirne Film Festival team are among the coordinators of the Katadrom Association and the founders of the association.

International Crime and Punishment Film Festival - 2011-2012 - 2013
